ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS AND OFFENSES AGAINST STATE LAWS
SUBJECT TO FORFEITURE OF CHAPTER 9, CRIMINAL CODE,
ARTICLE 1: MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES**

**THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ASHWAUBENON DOES ORDAIN
THAT SECTION 9-1-1 BE REPEALED AND RECREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Section 9-1-1: Ordinance Violations and Offenses Against State Laws Subject to Forfeiture

The following are sections of this Chapter and Wisconsin Statutes numbers following the prefix "9" defining offenses against the peace and good order of the state which are adopted by reference to define offenses against the peace and good order of the village, provided the penalty for commission of such offenses hereunder shall be limited to a forfeiture imposed under Section 1-1-13, Ashwaubenon Municipal Code
